Rules – 1st Annual Tri City Youth Tournament

1. This tournament will abide by the Rules and Regulations of the United States Bowling Congress.
2. This will be a handicap tournament. Handicap will be set at 90% of a 230 base.
3. There will be three (3) average divisions for handicap and scratch events:

SINGLES:	110 & UNDER	111 – 140	141 & UP
DOUBLES:	220 & UNDER	221 – 280	281 & UP
TEAM:	440 & UNDER	441 – 560	561 & UP

4. Awards will be purchased from the expense money. Awards for each handicap division will be based on a 1 to 8 ratio or the major fraction thereof with a maximum of 3 places and a minimum of 2 places. 1st place in each scratch division will be awarded.
5. The highest current average, in any sanctioned league, as of Saturday, February 5, 2022 (including games rolled on November 5th, 2022) based on a minimum of three (3) complete league sessions bowled, will be used. If a bowler does not have three (3) league sessions as of Saturday, February 5th, 2022, they may use their highest current average, in any sanctioned league, as of Saturday February, 19, 2022, based on a minimum of three (3) league sessions, provided they supply a league standing sheet, including all games bowled up to and including Saturday, February 19th, 2022. All other bowlers will bowl scratch in the highest average division.
6. All entry forms must be completed properly and in their entirety. All fees must accompany entry forms unless forms are emailed. Checks failing to clear on the 1st deposit will be returned and must then be resubmitted in the form of a cashiers check or money order with a \$35.00 surcharge added. Entries falling into this category will not be considered until their resubmitted fees are received.
7. The Tournament Directors for the 2021 City Youth Tournament are Rodney Bruton, Brian Kidder & Jennifer Bowling.
8. Multiple entries will be allowed in TEAM and DOUBLES events only. No more than two (2) bowlers from a previous team may enter together or another team. The same doubles pair can enter only once. SINGLES can only be entered one time. All-Events scores will be computed based on the highest score in each event.
9. Entry deadline (postmark date) is Midnight, February 14, 2022. You may also email PDF or JPG format of the entry forms to tournament director and mail the check.
10. Any youth bowler wishing to participate in this tournament but is not a USBC member may purchase a USBC Tournament Participation Card prior to the tournament if they qualify under USBC Youth Rules
11. League average sheets, including all games rolled through Saturday, February 12, 2022, must be submitted as soon as possible for average verification. These can also be emailed as PDF or JPG format to tournament director.
12. All bowlers must wear suitable attire at the discretion of the Tournament Director or the designated representative. Those violating this rule will be required to change to appropriate clothing or will not be allowed to bowl. Suitable attire is described as: clean clothes, without holes, shorts and skirts must be longer than the bowler's fingertips when standing with arms hanging naturally at their sides, covered midriffs (while in the act of bowling) and pants must be worn at the natural waistline. Clothing or towels with foul language, gestures, gambling, illegal substance, tobacco, vapor, or alcohol products; head coverings (except for medical reason), crop tops and tank tops are not permitted. Athletes are not allowed to use any tobacco or vapor products at the tournament site. Smoking or use of vapor products for guest is allowed outside only. Athletes and spectators are not allowed to use foul language at any time during the tournament and will be subject to disqualification and ask to leave the center.
